11.1 Introduction:- We identified Un- organized and unskilled workers at slums areas of Guntur town, those who are doing domestic work and construction work and doing labour and earning their livelihood. In this year we identified 70 women and formed into small groups. One will be elected as a leader and given training to them awareness of the Domestic workers rights and trade Union.



Area covered: 11 slums where more domestic workers are covered.

Members benefited: 349

- 70% of domestic workers were registered in chendranna Bheema pathakam
- 70% of domestic workers were registered in NTR vaidya seva . 4of them got benefitted. Kidney and knee surgeries had been conducted.
- 80% of children from 9 months to 15 years were immunized.

- d) Nearly 50 members started making detergents, cleaning solution and utilizing and saving consumptions.
- e) 50 domestic workers at sarada colony paying house tax in order to get B. Farms for housing scheme.
- f) 20. Domestic workers at Bajara Naik colony registered in Mee Seva for regulation of encroachment in Govt. lands and rural areas
They could fight to their benefits got house patta, drinking water, and training on tailoring, rickshaws, attended for house and cooking training conducted by MEPMA.

11.5 Great achievement : In the name of the Domestic workers Federation, Andhra Pradesh, the trade union registered with the registration NO. H-187/2017/AP. The members started to pay fee RS. 10/ and Membership fee Rs. 60 per Annum. 114 Members paid and became members in it.
